Parking:

- **Volunteers will get reserved parking in the NEW Mulch lot. This is at the far end of the Event Center.** There will be a parking flag and “volunteer parking” A-frame. If the mulch lot is full when you arrive, you can park in the grass lot next to the mulch lot
- Please **print out your parking pass and display it on your dashboard.** If you need a pass printed for you, they are available at the BSP Gift Shop 9am-5pm each day
- Please **arrive 15 minutes early** to your shift to account for traffic and to allow for time to walk to the Nature Pathway from the parking lot

Check In:

- **Check in with Kaitlin** at the “BSP Vols Tent” notated by a cream dot on the event map. The check-in tent will be BSP branded at the end of the Nature Pathway. I will also have a “volunteer check-in” flag next to the table

- Please wear your BSP volunteer uniform
