

AAPI Cultural Celebration 2026 Volunteer Information Guide

Parking:

- Please arrive **20 minutes early** for your shift to allow time for parking. Due to the high volume of guests, we are expecting a wait at the gate to enter the Park, so please be patient
- Parking for volunteers during their shift is free. Preferred parking for guests is now \$10 plus processing fees. Preferred parking is anywhere inside the gates of the Park. Parking outside the main gates is still free
- Volunteers do not need a physical parking pass for this event
- You will be sent an email from JustPark. When you receive the email, click on **“Accept Pass”**
- Once you press “Accept Pass,” you will be taken to a webpage. Scroll down until you see **“Accept Pass by Email Only”** and click on **“Email Only”**
- A QR code will populate. You can take a screenshot of the QR code or print out the page. You will also receive a separate email with the QR code. **You MUST show this QR code at the gate to gain entry**
- Volunteers will have reserved parking in the **Mulch Parking Lot near the Depot. Look for the "Volunteer Parking" sign**
- Please **carpool** if you're able
- Even if you are getting dropped off, your ride **must** show the parking pass from JustPark to gain entry into the Park gates

Check In:

Check in with Kaitlin at the “Info/Volunteer Check In” tent notated by a **green square** on the event map.

Attire:

Please wear your BSP volunteer uniform.

Points of Contact:

Any of the POC's may ask volunteers to move locations or change roles as needed. All will be wearing a BSP polo shirt and nametag.
